

Instruction**Supplemental Hourly Instruction for Qualified Students.**

“Supplemental Hourly Instruction” is defined as additional instruction outside of regularly scheduled instruction. Supplemental Hourly Instruction is to be offered either during the summer, before school, after school, on Saturdays or during intersession as detailed in Education Code 37252.8 Section 2(b).

Mark West Charter School has adopted a school calendar that provides at least 36,000 instructional minutes for Kindergarten students, 50,400 instructional minutes for Grade 1-3 students, 54,000 instructional minutes for Grades 4-8 in accordance with Senate Bill 434. Mark West Charter School applies student retention policies in accordance with Educational Code 48070.5,

Mark West Charter School defines students in grades 2-9 as “retained or recommended for retention” pursuant to Education Code 37252.2,

Mark West Charter School defines students in grades 2-6 as “at risk of retention or academically deficient” pursuant to Education Code 37252,

Mark West Charter School defines students in grades 7-12 as “at risk of failing the California High School Exit Exam” pursuant to Education Code 37252,

Mark West Charter School defines students in grades K-12 as “requiring additional core instruction” pursuant to Education Code 37253,

Mark West Charter School shall record student attendance on an hourly basis for instruction defined as supplemental hourly instruction.

Mark West Charter School’s Board of Directors authorizes Mark West Charter School to offer, subject to resource and funding availability, supplemental hourly instruction to students

(1) in grades 2-9 who have already been retained or are currently recommended for retention, and/or

(2) in grades 7-12 who are at risk of failing the California High School Exit Exam, and/or

(3) in grades 2-6 who are academically deficient or at risk of retention and/or

(4) in grades K-12 and require additional core subject instruction.
